Teaching Location:

Lessons will take place in the teacher's home or at the student's home.

Pricing:

For lessons in my home:

\$25 for a 30 minute lesson

\$40 for a 45 minute lesson

\$55 for an hour lesson

For lessons in the student's home:

\$40 for a 30 minute lesson

\$55 for a 45 minute lesson

\$70 for an hour lesson

All new and/or potential students receive their first lesson free!

- Methods of payment accepted: cash, Paypal (kparillo@gmail.com), or a check made out to Kimberly Parillo
- The student, or the family of the student, pay on a monthly basis at the first lesson of the month
- Policy on student absences: A 24 hour notice before the lesson is required to avoid still paying the full price for the lesson. Exceptions include emergencies, illness, or inclement weather.

Equipment needed:

- Bass (for help with picking an instrument, or for advice on where to get one, please do not hesitate to contact me)
- Bow
- Pop's Rosin
- Tuner and Metronome
- Books (to be decided depending on the level of the student)
- Cleaning cloth
- Spiral bound or composition notebook for lesson notes

For the lesson:

- Students are expected to bring their bass and all related equipment/books to each lesson
- Students need to keep their fingernails cut below the fingertip

Practice requirements:

Beginning students should aim for 20 to 30 minutes 4 or 5 days a week. As the student progresses, they can move up to 6 days a week for 30 minutes to an hour.

Much of the information above is for the benefit of beginning students. I do teach bassists of all experience and playing levels.
